Town Manager's Report

JANUARY 2011

Streets:

- Staff cleaned East and West Main Street.
- Staff repaired a number of street lights.
- Staff plowed and salted streets and sidewalks.
- Staff removed the Christmas decorations around town and the Community Center.

Water:

- Rainbow Lake is flowing over the spillway level and is frozen over.
- The roughing filters are being backwashed twice per day and the DE filters are being done once per week.
- Staff performed a number of water leak repairs.
- The water levels in our wells are 5.5' lower than May 2010.
- Water production and consumption. We produced and purchased an average of 327,644 GPD. We consumed an average of 295,294 GPD.

The difference is "Backwash Water" \dots (9.8%). We purchased 348,950 gallons of water from MSM this month.

- o 44.6% of this water came from wells.
- o 3.4% of this water came from Mt. St. Mary's.
- o 52.0% of this water came from Rainbow Lake.

Wastewater:

- The overland flow treatment system is shut down for the season.
- We removed a block of build-up grease from the pumping station wet well equal to about 1000 gallons or 5000 lbs.
- We received about 2.2 inches of precipitation this month (the average is 3.7 inches).
 - We have a precipitation **DEFICIT** of 1.5" over the last six months. The average precipitation for the period from August 1 thru January 31 is 22.1". We have received 20.6" for that period.
- Wastewater Treatment:
 - We treated an average of 268,000 GPD (consumed 295,294 GPD) which means that 0.0% of the wastewater treated this month was "wild water".
 - We did not exceed the plant's design capacity during the month of January.

Trash:

• Trash pickup will remain Mondays for the remainder of month of February.

Parks:

• Staff has been performing general maintenance in the parks.
